

CANR Curricula and Courses Committee
Meeting Minutes – Final Copy
February 3, 2012

I. The meeting was called to order at 2:09 pm by committee chair Mike Darre. Members present were: Marilyn Altebello, Rhonda Brownbill, George Elliott, Cameron Faustman, Sal Frasca, Susan Gregoire, , Gary Kazmer and Jason Vokoun (sitting in for Mark Rudnicki)

II. The minutes of December 16, 2011 were approved with correction of a typo to item CANR CC 11-12-43.

III. Old Business: It was brought to the attention of the committee that some of the courses that had changed their numbers may have to add the statement “Formerly offered as YYYY####” to allow students to apply for repeat forgiveness. Mike Darre will check with the registrar about this.

IV. New Business:

A. The Department of Animal Science proposes the following:

1. REVISE: Requirements for the Major

- 1) Add BIOL 1108, CHEM 2241 and CHEM 2242 to Group A.
- 2) Add either MCB 2000 or MCB 2610 or ANSC 4341 to Group A and remove MCB 2000, 2610, or 3010 from Group C.
- 3) Change Group C requirements from two courses to one course.
- 4) Indicate that no single class can satisfy more than one requirement.

Current Catalog Copy:

Animal Science majors must pass all courses from Group A, at least one course from Group B, at least two courses from Group C, and one additional course from either Group B or C.

Group A. (All of the following) ANSC 1001, 2111, 3121, 3122, 3194, PVS 2100, BIOL 1107, and CHEM 1122 or 1127Q or both 1124Q and 1125Q

Group B: ANSC 2251, 2271, 3261, 3272, 3273

Group C: ANSC 3313, 3323, 3343, 4341. Either MCB 2000 or 2610 or 3010 can fulfill one of the Group C requirements.

Revised Catalog Copy:

Animal Science majors must pass all courses from Group A, at least one course from Group B, at least one course from Group C and one additional course from either Group B or C. No single class can satisfy more than one requirement.

ANSC 1001, 2111, 3121, 3122, 3194
BIOL 1107, 1108
CHEM 1122 or 1127Q or both 1124Q and 1125Q
CHEM 2241, 2242
PVS 2100
One of the following: ANSC 4341, MCB 2000, MCB 2610

Group B:

ANSC 2251, 2271, 3261, 3272, 3273

Group C:

ANSC 3313, 3323, 3343, 4341

There was some discussion by the group about the availability of the CHEM 2242 labs, since they are only offered one semester each year. Also about how well prepared for CHEM 2242/2242 the students are who only take CHEM 1122.

2251. Horse Science (235) Three credits. Two class periods and one 2-hour laboratory or discussion period. Nadeau
Valuable to animal science majors. Includes horse types and breeds and their nutrition, breeding, evaluation, behavior, care and management with attention given to detailed studies of the problems and practices of horse production and use. **Taught concurrently with SAAS 251.**

Turfgrass physiology related to growth and development. Turfgrass response to nutrients, temperature, light, water, and traffic. Turfgrass community dynamics, competition, and environmental effects on turfgrass management.
