CATALOG STATEMENT: This minor provides interested students with an in-depth exposure to all aspects of dairy farm management. Students will have the opportunity to manage a portion of the UConn dairy herd and be responsible for daily activities and short and long-term decision-making.

REQUIREMENTS: All students are required to complete 18 credits from the following courses.

- At least 12 credits must not duplicate courses used in the student's major, or in other minors in the College of Agriculture, Health and Natural Resources.
Students must earn a grade of "C" (2.0) or higher in each individual course listed above.
Students must earn a combined grade point average of 2.5 or higher for all courses listed above.
Students must complete all requirements for a baccalaureate degree. Once the minor has been declared, it will appear on the student's transcript.
